Volunteer Position

The Board of Selectmen are seeking a letter of interest from anyone wishing to be appointed as a member to the Casey Road Town Forest Committee. There is a vacant position which has a term expiration of March 31, 2017. The Casey Road Town Forest Committee consists of five members with staggered terms. The Casey Road Town Forest Committee was established in 2015 to review the land located at Map 41, Lot 69, on Casey Road. The property is approximately 73.4 acres in size. The property has roadway frontage on Casey Rd with some slight roadway frontage on Winding Hill Rd and Farmington Rd (Rt. 75). The property was tax-deeded by the Town in 2009. The property has no structures on it and is primarily wooded. The property card describes it as “rolling and wooded”. In 2016 the town voted to approve warrant article 14 to place a conservation easement on the property. The primary objective of the Casey Road Town Forest Committee is to review the land and come up with recommendations for the property such as what should or should not be allowed on this property. Once recommendations have been established they would be brought back to the Board of Selectmen for approval. Guidance and input from the Conservation Commission is provided to the Casey Road Town Forest Committee. This is an advisory board subject to the perview of the Board of Selectmen.

The Casey Road Town Forest Committee must adhere to all applicable state laws such as RSA 91-A. Questions concerning the position and the responsibilities of the committee may be directed to the Board of Selectmen or the Conservation Commission.

Anyone interested in being appointed to this position are asked to submit a letter of interest to the Board of Selectmen via the Land Use Clerk at the Town Hall.
