Conservation Commission Member Position

Term Expires March 2019

The Board of Selectmen are seeking a letter of interest from anyone wishing to be appointed to a vacant position on the Conservation Commission. The position is a Member Position. For the term which expires March 2019.

The Conservation Commission consists of five members with staggered terms and three Alternate positions.

The Conservation Commission follows all applicable state laws, particularly RSA 36-A. Interested parties should have an interest in conservation and the environment in general. Some of the duties and responsibilities include monitoring natural resources of land and water areas, keeping an index of all open space, marshlands, swamps, etc., monitoring conservation easements, in addition to other duties. Interested candidates are strongly encouraged to read RSA 36-A and RSA 91-A in its entirety to be completely familiar with the required legal responsibilities and duties of the Conservation Commission.
